## THE ADULT DAY PROGRAM

The Adult Day Program provides support for adults experiencing physical and/or cognitive impairments that prevent them from functioning at their optimum level. Please call for more information.

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

The clients participate in various activities including chapel, exercise, reminisce, crafts, music, and community trips as well as visiting and socializing with residents.

Clients enjoy morning and afternoon nutritional breaks in their own program room. A delicious full course meal is served at noon in the Dining Room. Special dietary needs can be accommodated.

Minimal assistance with activities of daily living is provided by the Day Program staff. Consultations with a Registered Dietitian and/or for Pastoral Care are available upon request. Hairdressing or foot care may also be arranged for an additional fee.

Clients are provided with a monthly Day Program Activity Calendar.



Clients who require medication administration during the program hours provide their own medicine. The clients' name, medication name, dosage and time of administration must be clearly marked on the envelope or container.

The Day Program staff will inform the clients' family and/or support person of any significant changes or incidents. We also ask that families and/or support persons notify the Day Program Staff of any changes in the status of the client, such as medication changes, hospitalizations, use of Relief Care Bed Programs, etc.

Short notice cancellation occurs when the day program staff are not provided with a minimum of two weeks notification of client absence. Please note that no credit is given for short term cancellation, but scheduled days may be adjusted to meet the needs of the client or family/support person.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Spencer Home is a least scent environment. Please refrain from using scented products.

Emergency medical services are provided through 911 ambulance services and transfer to hospital.

### ADMISSION/COST OF DAY PROGRAM

An individual may be admitted as a private pay or as a Long Term Care subsidized participant.

If you receive Home Care Services through the Department of Social Development Long Term Care Program ask your Social Worker to refer you to the Adult Day Program, or call 1-866-426-5191 to find out if you qualify for a subsidized rate.

Payment is due upon receipt of invoice.
